# Drypysed Bylaw Changes:

The following changes are proposed in regard to the Board position of Member-At-Large. The title is to be replaced with Director of Purchasing along with a revision of duties. To allow for plenty of notice, these proposed revisions to the bylaws will be voted on at the Membership Meeting on **Monday, March 2, 2020**.

### ARTICLE V: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. There shall be a governing Board of Directors which shall be made up of these elected officers: President, 1st Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, and **Director of Purchasing**. In addition, there shall be one (1) representative from the City, who shall act only in an advisory capacity.

### ARTICLE VII: OFFICER DUTIES

Section 5. The Corresponding Secretary shall assist the President in matters pertaining to the correspondence of the organization. It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to create, edit, and disseminate the monthly newsletter **via email and mail in conjunction with the Newsletter Committee**. It shall also be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to maintain a membership database and disseminate a monthly list of active members to the President, Receptionist Committee, and Sunshine Committee, as well as an inactive members list to the Receptionist Committee.

Section 7. The **Director of Purchasing** shall purchase all supplies for the organization. **It** shall also be the duty of the Member at Large to mail the monthly newsletter in conjunction with the Newsletter Committee and Corresponding Secretary.

### **ARTICLE VIII: COMMITTEES**

Section 6. Newsletter Committee – This committee shall be responsible picking up from the printer, processing, and delivering the newsletter to the post office each month or as needed. The **Corresponding Secretary** shall serve as the chairperson.

The Mussell Center is open from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. Please enter the building during those hours only. This will enable the facility staff time before and after to tend to their daily maintenance tasks. The facility staff will unlock the front doors when the building is open.
