The **2020 US Census starts April 1** and will end in late June. For more information, click on <u>www.SantaBarbaraCountyCensus.org</u> or email <u>CensusSBC@countyofsb.org</u>. Every person living in Santa Barbara County will have the option of responding to the 2020 Census online (<u>mv2020census.gov</u>), by phone (844-330-2020 in English; 844-468-2020 in Spanish; 844-467-2020 for TDD), or by mail (you can request a paper form). If you respond by April 27, no one will need to visit your home. To avoid any scams, please note that all staff representing the US Census Bureau will always show a valid Census Bureau ID and will never ask for the following:

- Payment to fill out the questionnaire
- Social Security Number
- Financial Information
