July is National Parks and Recreation Month! The warm weather and longer days make a perfect combination to explore the hundreds of acres of City parks, trails, and open space.

Recreation Supervisor, Cindy Hoskins, has been working with Wendy Hudson to develop the plans to reopen the Elwin Mussell Center when we are approved to do so. There is an attestation process through the County that has to be completed by both the City and the Senior Club in order to open up. No date has been set at this time. We will be sending out a survey soon to obtain your input on how best to welcome you back to the Mussell Center so be on the lookout for that.

We miss seeing you in person! Since we cannot be together at this time, we want to encourage you to stay connected through the **Facebook** pages for <u>City of Santa Maria Recreation and Parks Department</u>, the <u>People for Leisure and Youth Inc. (PLAY Inc.)</u>, and the newly created <u>Elwin Mussell Center</u> page.
