# GREETINGS FROM THE RECREATION & PARKS DEPARTMENT

After a year-plus closure, it has been wonderful to see so many Senior Club members visiting the Mussell Center since the re-opening in June. Most City and Senior Club sponsored programs are starting again in August and some are starting in September depending on the facility reservations. Other programs will open once we know we have enough people who want to attend. If you have a specific program idea you want us to start, please let me know. We are always looking for good ideas and some of the best ideas come from the seniors who frequent the Mussell Center.

As we navigate the reopening of the Center, for the safety of staff and patrons, there have been several changes that have taken place. One of these changes includes the implementation of the free *Active Living Access Pass*. The Access Pass is a card with your photo on it that you will scan upon your arrival to the Center each day. (Many of you are already familiar with using this pass system when utilizing the exercise room at the Maldonado Youth Center). This Access Pass not only ensures your emergency contact information is available for staff should the need arise, but it also enables staff to keep an accurate count of patrons visiting the Center each day. This information is very helpful in obtaining appropriate resources and funding to continue to provide free and low-cost programs and services to the active adult community. Thank you to everyone who has already applied. It is going to take a few more weeks for this card system to be implemented, but they should be ready soon.

National Night Out is a family-centered event for all ages. It will be held from 5:30 to 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 3, in the new Bobby Acquistapace Park located at 1921 South Western Avenue (at Sonya Lane). The free event is a Police Department-community partnership event and includes live music, food, games, dancing, pony rides, and information about community resources from a variety of local agencies.


